National Immunization Awareness Month

August is National Immunization Awareness Month! The CDC has developed a toolkit to facilitate conversations about the importance of immunizations. The toolkit for parents can be found <u>here.</u> The toolkit for healthcare providers is located <u>here</u>. The CDC also suggests:

- Talking to your child's doctor or nurse about any routine vaccines your child may have missed.
- The immunization schedule is designed to provide immunity (protection) early in life, before children are likely to be exposed to serious, potentially life-threatening diseases.
- Some vaccines require more than one dose to provide your child with the best protection. Each recommended dose is important.

Back to School time is here which means scheduling your child's appointment for their routine vaccinations. Check out the links below for information about immunization clinics and events in your area!
