
# Help Me Grow North Texas is Officially 3!






### #FatherhoodFriday

The conversation to prevent bulling can start as early as a when a child learns the difference between kindness and unkindness. Did you know at least 1 out of every 5 kids in the United States is bullied? In Texas, at least 40% of those who are bullied have seriously considered suicide. To give caregivers the tools to empower their children to be anti-bullying champions and to get messaging out about bullying prevention, the DFPS PEI Communications Team created content designed to help caregivers have conversations with their children about bullying that can be posted on your organization's websites or social media channels.
