Importance of Early Childhood Intervention for Children with Autism

- An early diagnosis can mean a child gains access to important therapies and resources when they can be most effective
- ABA Therapy is shown to be most effective on toddlers and young children because their brains are not completely developed and have increased potential for developing new learning pathways!
- Children who receive Early Intervention have improved outcomes and increased success and independence later in life.
