

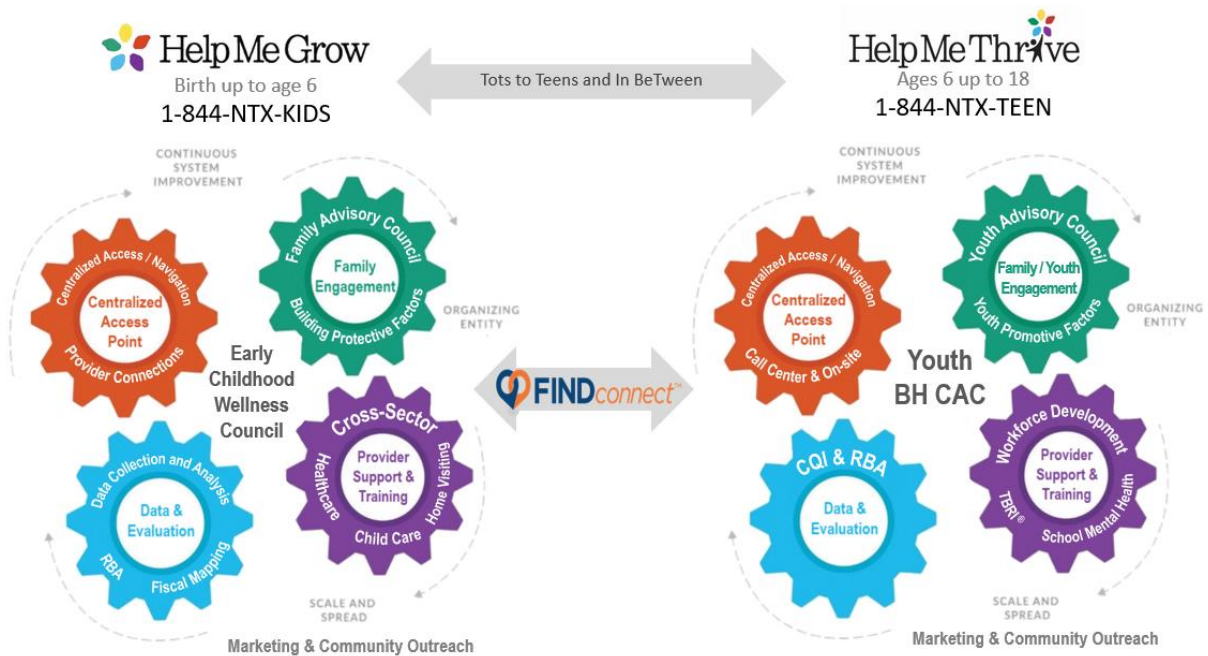
Partnership with Help Me Grow-Help Me Thrive North Texas

Overview

Help Me Grow North Texas is proud to be an affiliate of Help Me Grow, a national evidence-based model that works to promote collaboration across child-serving sectors in order to build a more efficient and effective system that promotes the optimal healthy development of young children ages 0 to 6. Help Me Grow serves to promote optimal development of all young children and identify those with developmental concerns as early as possible and connect them with appropriate services and interventions.

Help Me Thrive North Texas is a local enhancement of the Help Me Grow model but focusing on youth aged 6 to 18 in North Texas to also promote optimal development of youth and connect their families with appropriate services and interventions.

Four cooperative core components characterize the Help Me Grow-Help Me Thrive system model:



- 1) A **Centralized Access Point (CAP)** assists families and providers in connection to community-based programs and services.
- 2) **Family and Community Outreach** promotes family engagement and leadership as well as outreach to the community about services, programs and events.
- 3) **Provider Support and Training** links early childhood & youth service providers to high-quality training and supports developmental screening and intervention efforts.
- 4) **Data Collection & Analysis** supports evaluation, helps identify systemic gaps, bolsters advocacy efforts, and guides continuous quality improvement.

Benefits of Partnership

Help Me Grow & Help Me Thrive system of care models offer a variety of benefits to community agencies and individuals:

- 1) Quality materials and trainings to support optimal child & youth development
- 2) Bi-directional referrals for family serving organizations through the FINDconnect system
- 3) Support in implementation and/or expansion of developmental screening practice
- 4) Contribute to collective impact efforts to improve outcomes for all North Texas families
- 5) Increase equitable access to quality programs for marginalized families
- 6) Provide expertise to improve early childhood-youth serving systems
- 7) Support in implementation and/or expansion of family and youth engagement and leadership
